

Post Operative Discharge - Dental

- Your pet can have a small drink of water the same evening of the surgery, but if your pet vomits after drinking, withhold water until the next day. If tolerating water you may offer a small amount of food. If vomiting, withhold food until the next day. Call our office if vomiting persists or if no interest in food or water the day after surgery.
- 2. Your pet may prefer soft food for the next few days. Adding water to his/her normal dry food and allowing it to soak in should be sufficient. No special food is needed.
- 3. If you pet had extractions today he/she may experience some mild bleeding. Do not be alarmed, this may occur on/off for the next couple days. If bleeding is continuous or persists longer than a couple days please call the office.
- 4. If your pet has been on or is going home with antibiotics please give until gone.
- 5. Call our office if your pet is showing any sign of illness.
- 6. Call our office if your pet is showing any signs of discomfort or pain.
